- The grade point average for the previous academic year is confirmed by the relevant Dean's Office.
- Scientific achievements are confirmed by the supervisors of the Scientific Clubs
- Sports achievements are confirmed by the President of the University Club, Academic Sports Association or the AZS Supervisor.
- Points for individual artistic achievements are awarded based on diplomas or certificates received and confirmed by a member of the Recruitment and Benefits Section.
Group artistic achievements are confirmed by the group leader/supervisor.
- Places achieved in the Scapula Aurea, Great Synapse, and Superhelix competitions, as well as in the paramedic competitions, are confirmed by the relevant Head of Department.
- The place obtained in the medical simulation competition is confirmed by the Head of the Medical Simulation Center.
- The student is required to attach documents confirming the achievements listed in the application - achievements not confirmed by the appropriate document and signature of the appropriate person will not be awarded points.**
- First-year second-cycle students who graduated from a university other than Medical University of Silesia must provide certificates of their grade point average and achievements in the final year of their first-cycle studies from the university they graduated from, confirmed by the Dean of the Faculty.

The student must attach the following documents to the application for the Rector's scholarship:

- a) magazine articles:
 - title page of the magazine (month, year, volume number),
 - the first and last pages of the article,
- b) book/chapter:
 - title page of the book,
 - a page containing information about the book's author/editor, publisher, year of publication, place of publication, and ISBN number,
 - contents,
 - the first and last pages of the chapter,
 - the last page of the book with the text (in the case of a monograph),
- c) conference/conference materials:
 - the title page of the conference journal/diary in which the paper or conference abstract is published,
 - pages containing information about the name, place and date of the conference,
 - the first and last page of the paper or conference abstract,
 - conference regulations for the publication of a conference abstract in a journal with an IF for which no awards are granted
and a statement from the student that the publication of the conference abstract in a journal with an IF score, for which no awards are provided, and was not subject to prior evaluation by the University Scholarship Committee of the Medical University of Silesia,
- d) a certificate of an award received at a conference/congress,
- e) a certificate from the organizer confirming the place obtained during a sports competition,
- f) a certificate from the organizer confirming the place obtained during the competition/event referred to in the "other achievements" section,
- g) a certificate from the organizer about the award/distinction obtained in the artistic competition

Note: If the month and year of publication are not listed on the title page of the journal/relevant page of the book, the student must attach a certificate from the publisher containing the required information necessary to determine whether the work was published in the previous academic year.
